## AMERICA 250 RED WHITE AND BLUE

### Guidelines

- Safety is number one
- No fireworks
- Stay with your entry
- Maintain a safe distance between entries, 20-30 feet
- All entries need to be family-friendly and appropriate for all ages
- No jumping on/off floats
- No stunt driving
- No livestock
- No alcohol or smoking in or around parade entries
- No throwing candy, trinkets, toys etc.
- No weapons unless approved as part of a color guard or other specific unit
- No cell phone use for entry drivers
- Entries must be patriotic with red, white and blue colors
- Entries can be floats, tractors, classic cars, 4-wheelers, wreckers, trucks, golf carts, Masonic vehicles, Fire trucks, color guard, patriotic groups, marching bands, motorcycles
- All drivers need to have a valid driver's license
- Stage at the Texan, continue down N Kilgore St and turn on Kay St ending at the Kilgore City Park
- Start staging at 7:30am and starting the parade at 9:30am
